A Women Folk volunteer must be mindful of their body language, promoting a welcoming and helpful stance. They must be kind even to the most difficult of guests. They must have a strong love of working together as a team and great problem-solving skills. Our volunteers are extensions of the Women Folk Experience. You are the glue that holds all the work that has gone into this project together. You are so happy being a part of the day that phones are the last thing on your mind. You are grateful and happy to be in the present moment. soaking in every second as it unfolds. If this sounds like you, we can't wait to work by your side.

Front Gate/Tickets (3 hour shifts)

Scanning tickets, selling tickets, and directing folks where to go when they arrive at Music Experience. Must have a positive attitude and greet folks with a smile. Must be good with money. You will be the first faces that folks will see when they come to enjoy their day of music. We are looking for outgoing and fun folks to greet our guests.

Green Room (3 hour shifts)

We are looking for the nurturers, the healers and the calm folks who aim to make our artists feel like they are in their home away from home while they prepare to go on stage and share their gifts with an amazing audience. We are looking for folks who are willing to make the perfect cup of tea, fetch a water, and cater to our amazing female artists. We want them to be pampered and have a full spa like feeling while they prepare in the greenroom.

Trash Crew

Our trash crew is more of a roaming position. We are looking for folks who will keep an eye out on our trash cans and keep them from overflowing. Bringing full trash bags to our designated dumpster. This position also includes making sure our port-o-potties have toilet paper and making sure the hand sanitizing stations have plenty of sanitizer, paper towels etc.

Green Room Food Prep

Help out our chef prep food for his amazing meals for our artists. This job will also entail making sure our Security team gets their lunch and dinners served to them. Food prep workers will have an outstanding positive attitude ensuring all our artists get the nurturing food they need to get through their performance. Food prep will also help get food ready for any artists' children that are backstage. We want to create amazing healthy meals that restore and revive our artists and make them feel good from the inside, so they are prepared to share their hearts with our audience.

Main Stage (4-hour shifts)

Main Stage shifts will have an encouraging air about them. You will be in direct contact with our artists. You are the person who alerts them when they are "on deck" for their stage performance, where to go, where the dressing room is, have the bottles of water ready to go on stage for them. Etc. You are the one who will take 3 deep breaths with an artist if she is nervous and bring her peace and calm. If the artist needs space your intuition will guide you with ease to read the artist's energy. You are the big and final thumbs up an artist receives as they walk onto the stage. We are looking for experienced backstage volunteers for this position.

Band Gate

Our band gate volunteers are the first faces our artists will be greeted by as they arrive to the Womenfolk Music Experience. You will need to have a loving and welcoming heart. You will be checking our artists in and bands as well as their children and guests. You will have passes for anyone that is on the artists' guest lists. You will point the artists in the direction of the greenroom, where they can unload their gear, and where the daycare tent is (if they have children with them). This is for a person who is eager to start off the artists day on the right foot, filled with love and compassion and a gift of making folks feel at home.

Parking (4 hour shifts)

Parking attendants will direct folks to park in the designated field and pointing them in the direction of the front gate and ticket booth. Must be fun and energetic and greet folks with joy.

Vendor Help

As a vendor volunteer, you will help ensure that all our vendors have what they need to have a successful event selling their wares. You will be a problem solver and be able to think on your feet and communicate with our Vendor Operations Manger clearly. Our vendors are as important to us as our performers and our guests. You will be able to serve with a gracious attitude to help solve any issues that may arise.
